As ICE engages in enforcement actions, the ACLU of Oregon has been working with the <u>Oregon for All (https://oregonforall.us/about)</u> coalition, the <u>Portland Immigrant Rights Coalition (PIRC)</u> (https://pircoregon.org/), and other organizational partners and individual volunteers to support immigrant and refugee communities across our state.

Email from Oregon for All dated February 2, 2025

Dear Oregon for All (OFA) community partners,

Many of you are hearing of possible reports of ICE activity in Oregon communities, and we want to update you on what we can confirm.

The Oregon for All Rapid Response Team has a growing list of organizational partners and individual volunteers who respond to reports about possible ICE actions in communities across Oregon. We are thankful for community members who look out for each other, and we also ask people to be careful about not spreading unverified information, especially on social media.

The OFA coalition, including PIRC and ACLU of Oregon, attempts to verify all reports of ICE activity. However, many reports have not been confirmed. When we confirm that someone is detained, our first step is to ensure they have legal representation.

Legal representation: If someone is unrepresented, we immediately connect them to services through Equity Corps of Oregon (ECO), Oregon's universal representation program. Through PIRC, we also connect the detained person's family with other resources they may need.

The most critical information you can share with your community members is the following:

- Know Your Legal Rights to be prepared for an interaction with ICE. <u>Resources are available in</u>
 <u>English, Spanish, and Mandarin.</u> (https://www.aclu-or.org/en/know-your-rights-immigrants-rights)
- Know Your Rights videos.

 that might be helpful for community members. We are looking for high-quality Spanish versions to share.

- **PIRC hotline:** If community members observe ICE in their community, please immediately report it to the PIRC Hotline at 1-888-622-1510.
- Make a plan with your family. (https://www.ilrc.org/resources/know-your-rights-and-what-immigrant-families-should-do-now) Your family members need to know what steps to take if someone is detained, including where to find important documents and how your family should prepare.
- Enroll in the Equity Corps of Oregon. (https://equitycorps.org/attorney-directory/) You can get faster, free access to a lawyer if you are pre-enrolled in Equity Corps of Oregon. Call Equity Corps of Oregon (ECO) at 1-888-274-7292 (Mon-Fri, 9 AM-6 PM).
